Ms. Ruth MacKay, President of the Lyons Brook Women's Institute addressed Council and pointed out that the Women's Institute was initiated in Stoney Creek, Ontario in 1897 through the efforts of Adelaide Hoodless. She perceived a need for a women's organization to compliment the Farmer's Institute that served duly as an agricultural lobby and an educational forum. By 1913 WI branches were present in all provinces and under the sponsorship of the N.S. Department of Agriculture, Salt Springs became the very first branch of what would fall into Women's Institutes of Nova Scotia. The motto "for hope and country" reflects WI aims to help rural and urban women acquire knowledge and skills needed to meet the demands of life in a 21<sup>st</sup> century and to foster concern and cooperation among women for the betterment of home and country and the worldwide community. Meeting monthly WI branches take care of business, however the focus of each meeting is learning. Topics are as diverse as the membership and can be anything from decluttering our homes, making a traditional Mi'kmaq basket, learning about tartan design, growing an herb garden or finding out about the civil search and rescue association. Beyond mutual support and education provided through monthly programs WI is a project focused organization. In earlier days WI branches were active in supporting the war effort by raising money to purchase an ambulance, knitting hundreds of pairs of socks, providing cod liver oil capsules to students, lobbying for a school milk program, painting yellow lines of highways and more recently lobbying the provincial government on Lyme disease. Locally Pictou District branch supports community halls, school breakfast programs and bursaries, Roots for Youth, Viola's Place, Kids First, Tearmann House and hospitals just to name a few. Lyons Brook is the oldest of 9 active branches in Pictou District will celebrate its 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary on March 12, 2019. Lyons Brook in collaboration with other community leaders honored our village history by spearheading the collaboration of the Ship Betsy legacy in both 1992 and 2017. Curbside banners purchased with County Council's assistance for the 2017 event continued to highlight the village history to those travelling through Lyons Brook in the summer months. The community historical kiosk outlining the settlement, industry and social fabric of the village is a project realized once again through a collaboration of WI leadership with several other local residents. Lyons Brook responded to the Ivany Report by initiating Buy Local in Lyons Brook a very well attended market showcasing the wide diversity of enterprise carried on within our village. This sampling of close to home projects is complimented by participation of branches by district, provincial, national and international projects. A long standing partnership within Pictou District is a role that WI plays with respect to the Pictou North Colchester Exhibition. It is our members who receive entries, organize

judges and arrange displays of hand crafted art and food entries. Lyons Brook WI is just a small group and grateful to be honored for their efforts by Pictou County Municipal Council.

Warden R. Parker thanked the Lyons Brook WI for all the work they do and congratulated them on their 9<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

### **RECOGNITION OF INDIVIDUALS & GROUPS – MYLES O'BRIEN**

Clr. D. Parker introduced Myles O'Brien and his wife Jessica and he informed Council that Myles was a student of his from NRHS. He grew up on a small farm in Pleasant Valley. Upon graduating high school, he attended Acadia University for his Bachelor studies where he became interested in relating physical activity and aging through volunteering with multiple active aging programs. He then pursued his Master's at Dalhousie, studying the effects of different types of aerobic and resistance exercise training programs on blood vessel function in older populations. Now for his PhD at Dalhousie, he is switching his focus from treadmills and dumbbells to chairs and sofas, studying the effects of sedentary behaviours such as sitting, on the artery health of our aging population. Specifically, by 2030, 1-in-4 Nova Scotian's will be 65+ years of age. With advancing age, comes an increased risk of a cardiovascular events, such as a heart attack or stroke. Unfortunately, very little research investigating the influence of physical inactivity on blood vessel health has been conducted, particularly in older adult populations. Myles' research aims to uncover the immediate, short-term and long-term cardiovascular consequences of sitting too much, and investigates if participating in higher-intensity exercise outweighs the negatives of sitting. To answer his research questions, his lab uses Ultrasound technology to get a 'picture' of how blood vessel function changes in response to prolonged periods of sitting. His research has major implications for the development of active aging programs or cardiac rehabilitation programs, and informing guidelines aimed at reducing the prevalence of cardiovascular disease among older adults.

Myles has received an award from the Heart & Stroke BrightRed Student Research Awards Program that recognizes excellent emergency cardiovascular and cerebrovascular researchers in Nova Scotia at differing stages of career development. It provides financial support to students and trainees enrolled in research-based Masters, Doctoral, Postdoctoral and Doctor of Medicine training programs at academic institutions in Nova Scotia.

This year, Myles was awarded the Heart & Stroke BrightRed Mission Award, which is provided to the highest rated candidate of any academic level.

Myles' research program has also previously received funding in the form of a Dalhousie Nova Scotia Graduate Scholarship, Nova Scotia Health Research Foundation Scotia Scholar Award and a Mitacs Accelerate Internship Award.

Clr. D. Parker pointed out that we are very proud to see our young people excel.

Warden R. Parker and Clr. D. Parker presented Myles O'Brien with a certificate of recognition on behalf of the Municipality.

## **RESOLUTION – TAX EXEMPTION & TAX REDUCTION POLICY**

Clr. Boyles presented a resolution to Council as follows:

### **RESOLUTION**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Municipal Council for the Municipality of the County of Pictou that Council adopt the following policy with respect to tax exemption and tax reduction:



POLICY # 2019-01-12

### **MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF PICTOU TAX EXEMPTION & TAX REDUCTION POLICY**

1. This Policy shall be known as the Tax Exemption & Tax Reduction Policy.
2. This Policy shall apply to the properties listed in Schedules "A" and "B" and "C" commencing April 1, 2019.
3. Pursuant to section 71(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, the properties listed in Schedule "A" to this Policy shall be, subject to sections 4 and 9 of this Policy, exempt from real property taxation.
4. The tax exemption provided in section 3 shall apply to general tax only and shall only apply to the portion of the property specified in Schedule "A".
5. Pursuant to section 71(2) of the *Municipal Government Act*, the real property tax payable with respect to the properties listed in Schedule "B" to this Policy shall be, subject to sections 6 and 9 of this Policy, reduced to the tax that would otherwise be payable if the property were residential property, inclusive of area rates.
6. The tax reduction provided in Section 5 shall apply only to that portion of the property specified in Schedule "B".
7. Pursuant to section 71(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, the properties listed in Schedule "C" to this Policy shall be, subject to sections 8 and 9 of this Policy, exempt from real property taxation.
8. The tax exemption provided in section 7 shall only apply to general taxes and shall only apply to the portion of the property specified in Schedule "C", exclusive of sewer user charges and fire rates.
9. When a property listed in Schedule "A", "B", or "C" ceases to be owned or occupied by the owner indicated in the schedule, or if the property ceases to be occupied for the purpose, which pursuant to section 71(1) and 71(2) of the *Municipal Government Act* enabled the Municipality of the County of Pictou to include the property in this Policy, the tax exemption or reduction shall cease and the owner(s) of the property shall immediately be liable for the normal real property tax on such property for the portion of the taxation year then unexpired.
